Are Our Bad Habits Sins?

The purpose of this article is not to criticize, but to help. And the starting place is to clearly define the problems in the context of the principles found in God's Word.

Over the years in the Churches of God, it seems that there has been less and less emphasis on teaching that we have a duty to OVERCOME any personal character flaws or any negative PHYSICAL habits we may have. It seems to have become a fear to some of God's ministers that it might be thought that they are picking on someone, or by the same token that they might hurt someone's feelings by teaching on what is considered a delicate subject. The Bible teaches us that the Word of God cuts like a knife right to the heart. **Hebrews 4:12** *"For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."* If a minister teaches from the Word of God, then it is the Word of God that will convict the listener. The scriptures make it very clear that ours is to be a life of overcoming in ALL areas. Read Revelation. 3:21 *"To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with My father in His throne."*

You might question, "Isn't this talking about overcoming the world and its wickedness?" You would be right in asking this, and the answer is "YES!" But, wickedness can be anything having control over us that is not of God that causes us to sin. It doesn't matter if it's an excessive drinking problem, eating disorder, smoking habit, drug problem, or any other of the many vices a person may have. God's Word is very firm when it says that we cannot serve both God and mammon in Matthew 16:13.

Again, you might ask the question, "But isn't mammon referring to riches?" It's not just riches, He's speaking of here. The word mammon translated in figurative speech does say riches, but it also has the meaning, "confidence," as in putting your confidence in something, and it holds a deeper meaning of something being deified, or letting it become your god, and master. It's better understood what Jesus was speaking of if we look at the beginning of verse 13, where it says, *"No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other."* There is no gray area found anywhere in this verse.

And still in Matthew 5:48 we are told: *"Be [or become] ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect."*

How can I tell if something is controlling me or not? First, you have to ask yourself, "Can I stop? Do I control it, can I walk away from it, and never touch it or do it again? If you can't, then it has control over you.

We have to give God control of our lives and we have to put off the physical lusts and desires. The physical and mental desires that are contrary to God are sin. Read what it says in 1 John 2:14 *"Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. ¹⁷And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever."*

We all have to overcome the world and our lusts, but we need to do it with God's help. Read what it says in Proverbs. 3:6: *"In all thy ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct thy paths."* This is a goal which we will work on- or SHOULD be working on- until we die or until our Savior returns and we are changed. The life of a Christian is not to be one of just coasting or just marking time, waiting for the end, however and whenever that end may come for each of us.

Smoking is just one of the terrible destructive habits that hopefully few in the church have to deal with. And before we go any farther let us say that we should all be very sympathetic and SUPPORTIVE toward any brethren who have an addiction to tobacco, to any other addictive substance, or who may be trying to overcome any other controlling habits in their lives.

(Bad Habits, Continued on Page 6.) We all know that a host of physical illnesses can result from smoking, including heart disease, cancer, stroke and others. And one need only read the warning on the package to know tobacco is a health hazard.

A second issue on the subject of smoking is the issue of second hand smoke. For several years now we have understood that those nearby us- many times loved ones- can be damaged by the air we are fouling by our smoking. God's word tells us that we are not to do anything that harms our neighbor.

Romans 13:10: ***“Love worketh no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.”***

And in Matthew 22:39: ***“Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself.”***

Clearly putting our neighbor at risk with second hand smoke from cigarettes is NOT showing love to our neighbor and therefore not pleasing to our God.

Health problems can also arise from the **abuse** of legal and non-legal drugs, alcoholism, gluttony, and anything else that we over-indulge in. The Bible warns about these too.

Proverbs 23:19-21, ***¹⁹Hear thou, my son, and be wise, and guide thine heart in the way. ²⁰Be not among winebibbers; among riotous eaters of flesh: ²¹For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe a man with rags.”***

Peter warns us that we are to stop living the way we did before we knew Christ and to start living our lives according to the will of God.

1 Peter 4:1 ***“Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin; ²That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God. ³For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and abominable idolatries:”***

Paul confirmed this same idea in Romans 13:13-14: ***“Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. ¹⁴But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.”***

God's word tells us that our body is His temple and His Holy Spirit dwells therein and we are not to defile it. 1 Corinthians 3:16-17: ***“Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?”***

(17) If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.”

The abuse and defiling of our bodies is tempting God, especially with us knowing that the consequences of our actions could ultimately lead to the loss of health and/or destruction of our bodies, the temples of God. And doesn't the Word warn us not to tempt or test our God? Luke 4:12: ***“And Jesus answering them said unto him, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.”***

It seems to that if any of us one day should become ill from abusing our bodies and then decide to go to God asking for healing, we might indeed feel strange asking for healing while still putting ourselves in a situation in which we are daily contributing to the problem, wouldn't you agree?

As we indicated at the outset of this article, it seems that many of God's Churches have become- in our opinion- lukewarm in these latter days when it comes to teaching very important subjects and discussing issues that many don't like to hear and many don't want to hear. (Continued on Last Page.)

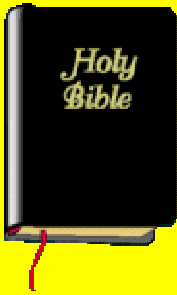

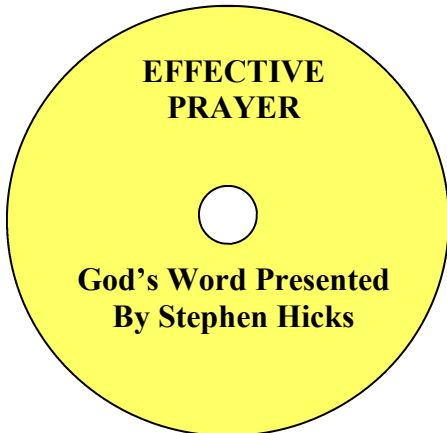

God's ministers are not to produce vain jangling with their words, but they are to preach every Word of God without skipping over the harder subjects.

The idea that we are to be DOERS and not hearers only seems to have gotten lost somewhere. But that is what God's word exhorts us to be.

James 1:22 tells us: ***“But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.”***

Getting control of our habits may be a terrible challenge for some reading this article and the thought of giving something up that you have been slave to for such a long time may cause great fear in you. Be strong and keep trying and ask us, your brethren, for help and support. Ask us also to pray for and encourage you. And remember you can do ALL things with Christ's help. Philippians 4:13: ***“I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.”***

Smoking, alcoholism, drug abuse, gluttony, along with many other lusts and desires are sin, but all of them can be overcome like any other sin. But, first we have to have a sincere, heartfelt desire to break the habit and make a change. Once we've made that decision then we ask God to forgive us and to help us with this change. God will help you, but He won't do it all for you. It will be a challenge for you and you will be tempted to return to what you are trying to escape, but each time you overcome you will get stronger. As you go through the challenge, remember to use your brethren for support and pray, pray, pray. But the most important key is that you don't give up. We all have bad habits in our lives, no matter how big or small, that we need to overcome, but together with God's help and by lifting one another up, we can all overcome and in doing so draw even closer to our Father.
