### **Preparing for the N.T. Passover/Lord’s Supper & the Feast of Unleavened Bread**

The Spring Holy Days are coming upon us quickly, so it’s time to start preparing, not only our homes, but more importantly ourselves.

In our home, a few weeks before the Feast, we usually begin going through the cabinets, freezers, etc. and pull out anything that contains items with leavening. We put everything with leavening on one shelf of the refrigerator, one spot in the freezer, or in one spot of the counter or a cabinet. It’s very easy to overlook things, so by starting early we can go through the same places several times.

Take time to read all the labels. I know that the print is very small on some of them, so you may need a magnifying glass to see it. Try not to buy anything with leavening that your family can’t use up before the beginning of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Anything remaining on April 18th should be put out in the trash by sundown or given away.

For a list of leavening products, just request one from us by phone, e-mail or regular mail. We also have a recipe book containing recipes without leaven that is available to anyone who requests it.

I’m sure that some of us, in the past, have accidentally ordered some kind of food with leavening during the Feast, realizing after the fact that we have made a mistake. Don’t go into a panic if it happens. Just as the Feast represents us putting sin out of our lives, we also have to realize that sin can easily creep in to our lives. Just correct the error by getting rid of the leavened items

and ask God to forgive you, just as you would repent and ask Him for forgiveness from any other sin.

A day or two before the Feast begins I write myself notes and place them in my vehicle, my work place, and around the house reminding me not to eat anything leavened during the Feast, and also to remind me to eat Unleavened Bread during each day of the Feast as the Word of God teaches. There are many, many distractions in our lives, so anything that we can do to help us keep our focus on our walk with God is a wise choice.

During the next several days we should be preparing ourselves to partake of the Lord’s Supper/N.T. Passover. So how do we do this? We have to get our mind focused on what these days mean to us now and what they represent for our future.

1 Corinthians 11:26-31 **“For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord’s death till he come. Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord’s body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.”**

It’s time to forgive old trespasses, put away any bitterness and begin mending any broken relationships, focusing ourselves on God’s way of forgiving and loving one another in a manner which pleases Him. If we get these out of the way, then we can truly focus on the meaning of partaking of the body and the blood of Christ. There is nothing wrong with asking God to show us what we need to change in our lives to draw closer to Him and to better serve Him.

In Old Testament times the people had to go through outward washings to prepare themselves to appear before God. You and I need only to prepare our hearts and our minds. In other words, we need to wash ourselves inwardly to prepare. It is up to each individual to get themselves and their homes prepared, so that they can come before God and honor Him with our lives and rejoice during his Holy Days. END

## Is God Responsible When Bad Things Happen?

There seems to be a widespread belief in professing Christianity that when bad things happen, it's God's will. To be sure, we are told in I Peter 4:12: **“Beloved do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you...”**

But that verse does not actually ANSWER the question, does God actually CAUSE the evil, that is the trials to occur? At first glance it might APPEAR so in a story that we find in 2 Chronicles 18:18-19: **“Then Micaiah said, Therefore hear the word of the Lord: I saw the Lord sitting on His throne, and all the host of heaven sitting on His right hand and His left. And the Lord said, Who will persuade Ahab king of Israel to go up, that he may fall at Ramoth Gilead?...”**

Ahab was an evil king of whom God finally had had enough. We are told earlier in the story that Ahab and those with him had sought the counsel of Micaiah, a man of God as to the battle. Micaiah goes on in verse 19 to tell what the "host of heaven," that is, the angels, replied to God: **“....So one spoke in this manner, and another spoke.”** Verses 20 and 21 continue, **“Then a spirit came forward and stood before the Lord, and said, 'I will persuade him.' The Lord said to him, In what way? So he said, 'I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his [Ahab's] prophets." And the Lord said, 'You shall persuade him and also prevail; go out and do so.”**

Here God clearly ALLOWS a FALLEN angel- a demon- to deceive Ahab's false prophets. And how do we know this is a demon, that is, a fallen angel? Micaiah tells Ahab so in verse 22: **“Therefore look! The Lord has put a lying spirit in the mouth of those prophets of yours, and the Lord has declared disaster against you.”**

How can we know that this spirit is in fact a demon? Because we know, first of all, that God cannot lie.

Numbers 23:19; **“God is not a man, that He should lie...”**

We also know that God HATES lying. Proverbs 6: 16-17: **“These six things the Lord hates, yes seven are an abomination to Him:.... (17) ....a lying tongue...”**

But that does not mean that God does not ALLOW lying. And lying is one of those things that Satan and his demons EXCEL in: John 8:44: **“...When he [Satan] speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.”**

We also learn from scripture that ALL angels, even fallen ones report to God. We find a fascinating record of just such an event in Job 1 beginning in verse 6: Job 1:6-7: **“Now there was a day when the sons of God [angels] came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan also came among them. And the Lord said to Satan, from where do you come? So Satan answered the Lord and said, From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking back and forth on it.”**

So we see here that Satan, who you might call the CHIEF demon, has to report to the God who created him, too. There then follows a dialogue in which God points out the virtues of His servant Job. Satan then challenges Job to remove the hedge of protection God has put around Job in verse 9-11: **“So Satan answered the Lord and said, Does Job fear God for nothing? Have you not made a hedge around him, and around all that he has on every side?... But now, stretch out Your hand and touch all that he has, and he will surely curse You to your face!”**

And in verse 12 we see that God DID allow Satan to attack Job but with (Continued on Page 7.)

**(Is God Responsible, Continued from Page 6.)** certain limitations: **“And the Lord said to Satan, Behold all that he has is in your power; only do not lay a hand on his person.”**

Notice here that God did not tell Satan to harm Job or anything he owned, but rather ONLY said Job's property would be in the "power" of Satan. It was Satan who decided to do the evil. In other words, God gave Satan CHOICE just as we have choice. Later in the story we see God gradually ALLOWING Satan's attack against Job to increase. Job's sons and daughters die, property is destroyed and eventually Job's body is stricken with painful boils. Job 2:7.

At NO time, however, could Satan do anything to Job unless God allowed it. In fact, God even allowed Satan to bring a windstorm, perhaps a tornado to destroy a house with Job's children in it.

Job 1:18: **“While he was still speaking [to Job] another also came and said, Your sons and daughters were eating and drinking wine in their oldest brother's house and suddenly a great wind came from across the wilderness and struck the four corners of the house, and it fell on the young people, and they are dead; and I alone have escaped to tell you!”**

We might incidentally keep these verses in mind as we see the upset weather conditions pounding the country as well as other parts of the world. But again, Satan, we must remember, can only do what God ALLOWS him to do.

In fact to illustrate the CONTROL that Jesus Christ had over demons when He walked the earth in human form, we go to Luke 8 where Jesus confronts a demon possessed man who is in fact possessed with several demons. We pick up the story in verse 31 where the demons have a dialogue with Jesus: **“And they begged Him that He would not command them to go out in the abyss. Now a herd of many swine was feeding there on the mountain. So they begged him that He would permit them to enter them. Then the demons went out of the man and entered the swine, and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the lake and drowned.”**

Putting aside the issue of the violent stampede of the swine, please notice that the demons had to ASK permission to go into the swine. The world is wrong when it mistakenly portrays a CONTEST going on between God and Satan. God is and always has been

sovereign and He is now and always has been in complete control. Nothing happens unless God allows it. The choice between good and evil that is given to mankind was also given to Satan and his demons. But, Satan, who was called Lucifer before he fell, along with a third of the angels, chose to do evil as Lucifer tried to elevate himself above God. Lucifer was created perfect, but iniquity was found in Him and He was cast down to this earth along with the angels that chose to follow him in his rebellion.

Ezekiel 28:11-15: **“Moreover the word of the Lord came to me, saying, Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, [a reference to Satan as we shall see] and say to him, Thus says the Lord God, You were the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. You were in Eden, the garden of God; every precious stone was your covering: the sardius, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, turquise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes was prepared for you on the day you were created. You were the anointed cherub who covers; I established you; you were on the holy mountain of God; you walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, till iniquity was found in you.”**

So here we see an angel, an archangel actually, who essentially has EVERYTHING. God has created him PERFECT. But "iniquity" is found in him. And what was that iniquity?

Isaiah 14:12-15: **“How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations! For you have said in your heart: I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.”**

**From then on he was no longer called Lucifer, but Satan, which in the Hebrew describes him as an opponent or adversary and in the Greek describes him as the accuser or a more commonly used name, “the devil.”**

Satan led a revolt! He wanted the Lord God's job. A better translation of that last verse in **Isaiah 14** would be "I will BE the Most High!" Satan had a choice, **either** to obey God or not. (Continued on Last Page.)

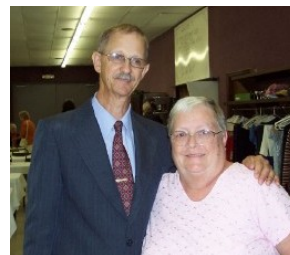

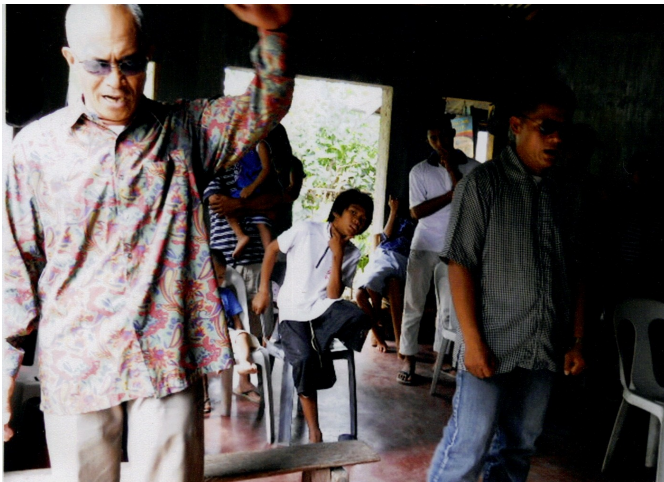

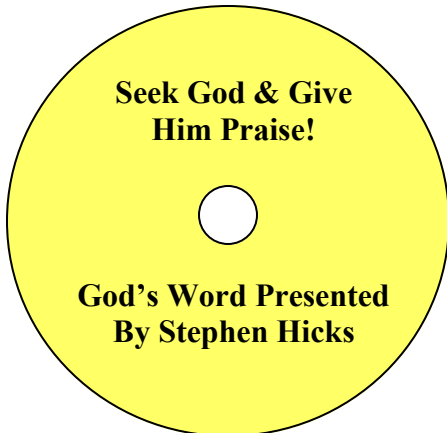

And there is the real cause of the evil in the world. God only sometimes ALLOWS it. And as we saw earlier, SOMETIMES the evil Satan does, over the long run, helps to carry out God's purposes, EVEN to the point of allowing Satan to enter into Judas and betray Jesus Christ. John 13: 21-30.

We can know, however, as spirit begotten children of God that ANYTHING that happens in our lives, whether good OR bad, will work for the GOOD in our lives.

Romans 8:28: "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."

On that, brethren, we may rely!
