**(Don't Make an Idol, Continued from Page 3)** Let's now take a look at some of the provisions INTENDED by those same founders.

Article 1, Section 2, Clause 3: *Representatives and direct taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their several numbers, which shall be determined by their adding to the whole number of free Persons, including those bound to service for a term of years, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons.*

Those of you who may remember your American history may recall that the "three fifths of all other persons," refers to slaves. Thus, the Founding fathers clearly enshrined the institution of slavery within that document. I know that the argument can be made that this provision was made out of political expediency, and that without it, there would have been no constitution, but isn't that the point? Since then, political expediency rather than Christian morals, has too often dictated how our laws are made and how we have lived our lives in this country. And as to this particular provision in the Constitution, do not think that no price was paid for it and for the odious practice of slavery in our republic. One of our most beloved presidents, Abraham Lincoln had something to say about that in his second inaugural address in 1865:

"One-eighth of the whole population were colored slaves, not distributed generally over the Union, but localized in the southern part of it. These slaves constituted a peculiar and powerful interest. All knew that this interest was somehow the cause of the war. To strengthen, perpetuate, and extend this interest was the object for which the insurgents would rend the Union even by war, while the Government claimed no right to do more than to restrict the territorial enlargement of it. Neither party expected for the war, the magnitude or the duration which it has already attained....

Fondly do we hope, fervently do we pray, that this mighty scourge of war may speedily pass away. Yet, if God wills that it continue until all the wealth piled by the bondsman's two hundred and fifty years of unrequited toil shall be sunk, and until every drop of blood drawn with the lash shall be paid by another drawn with the sword, as was said three thousand years ago, so still it must be said "the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether."

If, as some of our brethren believe, we need to get back to the INTENT of the Founding fathers as expressed in the Constitution, we can surely see the result of that intent in Mr. Lincoln's words. It resulted in a horrendous war that shattered the lives of hundreds of thousands of Americans. God's Word warns us away from depending on man's world and his laws. We are to look forward to a coming perfect world.

Romans 12:2: **"And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God."**

As to the assertion that I alluded to above, that we, as Christians, in the meantime, must work to slow down the degeneration of the country, we need only look to the model prayer, or as the world calls it, the Lord's Prayer, for an answer:

Matthew 6:9-10: **"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done. On earth as it is in heaven."**

In our courts and in our land in general, we see a gradual eroding away of any laws that even remotely uphold the laws of God. I believe that before too much longer, we will see the hideous abomination of homosexuality being enshrined within our laws and laws punishing those who speak out against it also being passed. We will find, I fear, when that time comes, that the U.S. Constitution will then be our enemy and not our friend.

There is one last point on this subject that I'd like to address. We know now that God's Word and His salvation is open to all the world, to those God now calls. Many of our brethren, in many parts of the world, many of whom I have met, are not subject to our constitution or our laws. The term "Founding fathers" is unknown to them. Indeed, for many of them, they have different founding fathers within their native lands. Our TRUE Founding Father FOR ALL MANKIND is in fact found in John 1:

John 1:1-4: **"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the life of men."**

This is the TRUE Founding Father and we need to study and understand His true Constitution, the Holy Righteous Word of God. Only there will we find the true answers to all of the questions we may ever have. This government, along with its constitution will eventually fall. The question you have to ask is, "Will you fall with it, or will you stand firm by faith in the coming Kingdom of God and the true Founding Father?"

## GOD'S CREATION AROUND US

I know that some of you may be a little squeamish about what I want to write about in this article, but I have always found this subject a fascinating creation of Almighty God.

This creation is a master designer and builder and I know that everyone of us has had some sort of experience with it. Often that experience is when you have to pull the sticky web from your hair or from your clothing after you've walked through its invisible trap.



Yes, I am writing to you about the spider. Spiders can be found just about anywhere and there are so many varieties that I don't have the space to put in pictures of them all.

I personally have always found watching spiders very fascinating. I have spent hours watching an orb spider in the woods drop down on his web from up to 15 feet from a tree limb, then crawl across rough terrain to another tree close by. It then crawled several feet up that tree dragging its web, still attached to the previous tree, and then attaching the end to the new tree branch.

For a many years, knowing how sticky a spider's web is, I wondered how that spider kept the web he was dragging behind him from sticking to everything it touched. Some of you may already know the answer, but after some research, I found out that a spider can produce two kinds of web. God has given the spider the ability to produce sticky and non-sticky strings of web.

If you've ever wondered how a spider keeps from getting stuck to its own web, this is why. Many webs that we are familiar with are created with strings of web stretching from one point to the next, running

from high to low, vertically and horizontally, then there is a spiral of web that holds these straight lines of web together forming a sort of net. The secret to the spiders ability to walk without getting stuck is that the straight web lines are not sticky. The only part of the web that is sticky is the spiral web holding everything together. The spider avoids the sticky web and walks only on the straight ones.

God has given them long legs with hook like features that allow them to avoid the sticky part of the web.

As I watched the orb spider, I noticed that he had to crawl an awful long ways to string the straight lines, but once



he was finished, he began tying them together with the sticky web, creating a net to catch unsuspecting insects as they flew through the forest. When the insect flies into the net, they are trapped in the sticky coating on the web and the spider then speedily crawls down one of the straight lines, through the maze of sticky lines and proceeds to wrap the victim in a cocoon of web. Once the spider has its prey subdued, the spider then injects a chemical into the insect which in turn dissolves the insides of the insect, so that the spider can then have a tasty meal. The spider may choose to drain the insect right then or it will save it in the cocoon for a meal later. Once it has drained its victim, it then releases the cocoon from the web and lets it drop to the ground.

After all of this there is usually major damage to the web from the struggles of the insect, so the spider begins the task of stitching up its web, filling any gaps and reinforcing it for the next victim.

The orb spider is just one type of spider. Most of us are probably familiar with the garden spiders, wolf spiders, common house spiders, jumping spiders and in some cases the poisonous brown recluse or black widow spiders.

To most people a spider is something that needs to be killed as soon as it's found, but spiders are one of God's creation and they have their place in the food chain.

Now, every time I walk through the woods and have to knock down a web or pull the web out of my hair I actually stop to think how long that spider had to work to build it and how long it's going to take it to repair the damage I created.

I love to see webs on frosty mornings, or when there is dew in the air.

I believe that the spider, with its ability to design and build such an intricate structure is one of God's more fascinating creations.

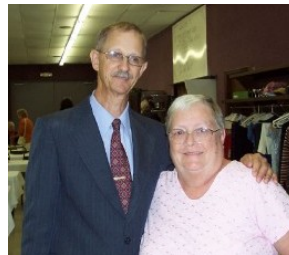

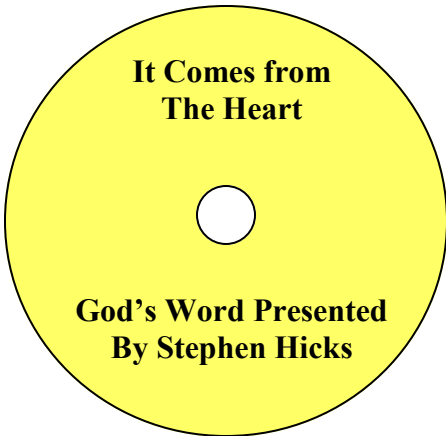

Many times we get so caught up in the world around us that we don't hear when God's Spirit is speaking to us, or as we read the Word, we can't always grasp the meaning of what we are reading, because of distractions that surround us.

Now I know that many of you can't always get out of town, but we still need to take some time out, each day if we can and find a quiet place with the least amount of possible distractions, and seek God's wisdom and guidance through worship, prayer, reading and meditating on His Word.

It is so easy for us to get caught up in our lives or other peoples lives and God gets shoved to the back burner.

Keep in mind that all of God's patriarchs and prophets of the Old Testament sought God when they needed to make decisions. When they didn't seek Him for guidance, whatever they were doing usually fail.

The Apostles and other disciples of the New Testament allowed God to direct them and speak to them through His Holy Spirit and through dreams and visions. They wouldn't have been able to hear that guidance if they allowed too many distractions to keep them occupied.

As a Counselor, God's Holy Spirit is there to help reveal the great and wonderful things of God. But we can't hear if we're not listening.

Take some time to find that quiet place that you can go and seek wisdom and understanding from our Father above. He really wants to hear from us and He wants to be a big part of our lives.
