I was out the other day and decided to drive by the lake. This time of the year is when the geese, ducks, and many other birds begin their migrations from the cold north and settle in our areas and areas farther south where the climate is a little more tolerable for them.



Blue winged Teals (above) are one type of duck that migrates. The geese that you will usually see will be a mixture of Canadian geese (left, and below) and Snow geese. I didn't see any snow geese on the lake, but I have seen a lot of them in open corn fields. In fact, there are so many of them at times it will look like the field is covered in snow.

Normally the Snow geese, the ducks, and most of the Canadian geese will return north when the weather begins to warm up, but quite often you will find some of the Canadians staying around to build nests and raise a family.

It's great in late spring when you see a momma goose walking along being followed by a bunch of fuzzy little goslings.

A while back on a trip to Bolivar, we crossed over Truman Lake and all packed together in a large mass on the lake, were some white pelicans. They were too far away from the road to get a good picture, but the sight itself was fascinating.

I remember one time while fishing with my dad, and as we sat there on the bank of a small lake, we saw a huge white mass of birds come flying in and landing on the lake across from us.

We were both in awe at the size of these birds, but they were too far away to really tell what they were. Well, curiosity got the best of me and I walked down over the bank of the lake and snuck around to where they were. As I peeked over the top of the bank, I could see that they were pelicans. I think about that day quite often, and always look forward to seeing them again. If you have a lake, or river close to you, take a day with your family, and just sit and see what kind of birds you will see. I know you will all enjoy it. Oh, and don't forget your camera and your binoculars.

IS CHINA FLEXING ITS MUSCLES?

Each year about 50 U.S. Navy ships are allowed to make port calls in Hong Kong.

Recently China refused entry to nine Navy vessels. Officials said that China denied permission to a U.S. Air Force C-17 flight that had been scheduled for a routine re-supply of the U.S. Consulate in Hong Kong. Reports also said that China refused two U.S. minesweepers from entering Hong Kong to escape bad weather on Nov. 21, then barred the aircraft carrier USS Kitty Hawk and its escort ships and an accompanying nuclear-powered submarine from docking in Hong Kong for a long-scheduled Thanksgiving port call.

Apparently, almost 290 family members of Navy seaman had traveled to Hong Kong to be with the sailors during Thanksgiving.

Was this China's way of flexing its muscles at the United States?

Past information has shown that China's military might was second only to the U.S. and that they were going to match and outgrow our military by leaps and bounds. It was two years ago that I read that report. I haven't seen a recent report on their military status, but at the rate they were building, I would say that if they haven't surpassed the U.S., they are very close.

China has also been having dealings with Russia for several years, and both of these Countries have been openly and secretly working with Iran to provide them with different things that they need in an attempt to keep negotiations open for future oil supplies.

These most recent pushes at the U.S. by China may be an attempt to show us that they will not be

bullied by the U.S in regards to Taiwan, a potential military flashpoint.

Mainland China claims that Taiwan is a renegade province, and says it has the right to seize control of the independently governed island with its military.

The Taiwan strait is barely 100 miles wide at its narrowest point, and they have 900 short range ballistic missiles aimed across the strait.

The U.S. has already stated that it would defend Taiwan against any attack by China, and that if the Chinese made this attack, they would be declaring war against on us too.

At the time these words were spoken, our military was a lot bigger then China's.

The one thing that I'm not sure that our military leaders have considered is that China and many of these countries have been able to sit back for years and observe our tactics, study our weaponry, and work out ways to overcome what we have.

If we would have to go to war with China, we would pretty much deplete our military forces, and possibly leave our own borders unprotected.

Our military is stretched pretty thin right now as it is. There are recruiting drives going on every day in an attempt to replenish the already depleted numbers. There have been talks about reinstating the draft again, and this could definitely become a reality if we should have to take on China. A military draft could affect a lot of people, including those in God's Church.

We have been blindly sleeping with our enemies for years, supplying them weapons, technologies, and even funding them. The problem is that now all of that could very easily, and probably will come back to hurt the U.S.

The U.S. is losing its respect and dominance in world affairs, and they don't even see it happening.

I have said for years now that our collapse would come from within, and I still believe that, and one or more of our enemies could take advantage of us at that point. Because of our sins, we will be punished by an enemy. God has used different countries in the past to punish His people, and I believe that He will do the same with the U.S.

Commentary by Tom Shadoin

I was shocked recently when a member in one of the many small church groups I visited told me what her horoscope said and how she had planned her day accordingly. This is only one more example where, as I've said many times, strong teaching is no longer coming from many of the church of God pulpits (or tapes or CD's as the case may be).

Someone commented recently that he knew the horoscope was not of God, but that it was fun, and according to him, what harm could come of it? The obvious answer is, if its not of God, then where else, pray tell, could it be from! For those of us in the greater churches of God, who still believe the Bible is the place where we should look for all our answers to our daily life (Proverbs 3:6), then let's see exactly what it says about such things as horoscopes, fortune-telling, divining, or in other words astrology in general.

A brief note to begin with. There is a difference between ASTRONOMY and astrology. Astronomy is the study of the night sky above us, stars, planets etc. NOTHING wrong with that. I love to look through a telescope admiring the breathtaking view at night of God's handiwork. David waxed poetic about the same thing. (Psalms 19:1) ASTROLOGY on the other hand is the "study" of the stars and star charts to determine our activities and futures. CLEARLY condemned by God as we shall see. or as one comedian once said, "The horoscope is all a bunch of Taurus!"

In Isaiah 47 God addresses one He calls the "virgin daughter of Babylon," (verse 1) and He warns of her "sorceries and enchantments." Interesting that He mentions Babylon, because history teaches us that much of the worship of pagan "gods" and of the stars above CAME from Babylon. In verse 13 of the same chapter God goes into detail as to who he means by including "astrologers, the stargazers, the monthly prognosticators..."

For those not familiar with horoscopes, as I have alluded to before, they are based on the so-called star charts. At the time I'm writing this, not only the MONTHLY prognosticators or fortune tellers will be out with their predictions in the cheap tabloid newspapers at the grocery check out lanes (next to the gum and candy!), but the YEARLY ones too, like Jeanne Dixon. Not surprisingly a year or so later, most of these predictions will prove to have been wrong.

Notice the difference again as to WHERE we should be looking for our knowledge and our wisdom. Verse 4. "As for our Redeemer, the Lord of hosts, is His name, the Holy One of Israel."

And what will be the final outcome for the people who seek their life's answers through these godless abominable methods? Verse 14: "Behold, they shall be as stubble; the fire shall burn them; they shall not deliver themselves from the power of the flame..."

Verse 15 ends the chapter with the ominous words, "...none shall save them." Somehow I don't think that their world's astrologers then saw such an end in their daily star charts! Early on when God led ancient Israel into the land He promised them, He warned them not to follow the heathen ways of the nations He would drive out before them. Through Moses He said in Deuteronomy 18:14-15: (14) For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the Lord thy God hath not suffered thee to do so." (15) The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto Him ye shall hearken;"

That Prophet has come. His name is Jesus Christ the Magnificent and of his Kingdom there shall be no end. We need to look to Him and only to Him.

Meantime, I'm not saying that the newspaper pages containing the horoscopes are worthless. They are in fact excellent for lining the bottoms of bird cages! END
