Commentary by Tom Shadoin

Since the breakup and scattering of the Churches of God a once well- settled issue has, for some groups, now become controversial. That is the issue of whether or not a Christian should serve in the military.

I should say at the outset that this article is in no way meant to criticize those who have served in the past or are even now honorably serving their country. Or those who have died in that brave service in the past. Those whom Lincoln called the "honored dead," should indeed be honored and respected by us. Us for whom, as Lincoln also said, they gave "the last full measure of devotion." In the history of the world no finer, no more devoted army has ever taken the field than that made up of the American fighting man and woman.

But God tells us in ALL our ways to acknowledge Him. (Proverbs 3:6.)

Is it indeed His will that so many go off to war and so many never come back or come back maimed or disabled? In His Word He claims to offer us a "more excellent way." (I Corinthians 12:31.) Does He offer us no better way than the savagery of war?

Those of us "old timers" can remember when we could hear the truth of God coast to coast on radio EVERY day of the week. Many times we were told of the example of World War I when the French and British soldiers on one side flocked to their churches and asked God to give them victory against the Germans and their allies. AND on the other side the Germans prayed to God for the same victory. Whose prayers then we were asked, was God supposed to honor? This is a very complex issue and, as such, will be explored in God's Word in more than one article on the subject.

Those who believe God is NOT able to fight our battles for us as a nation should probably stop reading here. But the scriptures say that God's hand is not shortened that it cannot save. (Isaiah 59:1).

A good example of that is found in 2 Kings 19. We pick up the story in verse 19 after Jerusalem is surrounded by the armies of the king of Assyria. The Hebrew king Hezekiah implores God to save them from certain disaster. In 2 Kings 19:35 God sends just ONE angel out which kills 185,000 Assyrians in only one night. We see clearly by this that God indeed CAN fight our battles for us. But why doesn't He do so today?

God told the Israelites in Deuteronomy 7:20 and Joshua 24:12 that He could drive out the Canaanites in the Promised Land by sending in swarms of hornets and NOT by the sword or the bow. But all along they doubted him and murmured against Him. And AFTER the Israelites have asked God for a king in 1 Samuel 8 He warns them in verse 12 that this will also include war and war making. The people insist however on a king and in their reply in verse 20 say: "That we also may be like all the nations; and that our king may judge us, and go out before us, and fight our battles."

God tells Samuel that the people have not rejected Samuel but that they have rejected God. (1 Samuel 8:7). This is what they desired even though God had told the people of Israel that He would fight their battles for them. (Deuteronomy 1:30-31; Deut. 3:22).

The book of James tells us where wars really come from. In James 4:1-3 we read:

(1) From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members?

(2) Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not,

(3) Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

Jesus says in John 18:36 when He was before Pilate that His Kingdom is not of this present world or age. If it were He goes on, then His servants WOULD fight. And in Matthew 26:53 He further told Peter (who apparently was about to become an army of one) to put up his sword, that He, Jesus, could summon twelve legions of angels to fight for Him if He so wished. And we just saw above in 2 Kings 19 what only ONE such angel could do!

Clearly then the military can not be a place for the Christian. In a 1966 federal military appeals case U.S. vs. Burry the court held that a Sabbath keeper COULD be compelled to cook on the Sabbath. This is still current law and if anyone wishes to contact me I would be glad to send a copy. Burry to his credit didn't cook but spent time in military prison instead.

In Leviticus 26:19, the so called blessings and cursings chapter, God tells us for disobedience to Him and His laws He will break the pride of our power. Those of us who remember Vietnam (Continued on Page9)

HISTORY OF THE JEWS, PART 2 (From Holocaust to Present)

Many of us have heard bits and pieces of Jewish history, but often times there are gaps in what we have come to understand. As I began to study on this subject I found that there were gaps in my understanding of the Holocaust and what events have brought the Jews to where they are today and what has kept them in a constant state of alert. Even today, the state of Israel remains on alert, wondering when things will explode again, launching them into another battle for the Promised Land.

Adolf Hitler took Austrian and German anti-Semitism and fused them by taking the fear of Jewish/Bolshevist Russia and the "Protocols of the Elders of Zion," and mixing it with Viennese apprehension of the Ostjuden, which were a dark and inferior race corrupting Germanic blood and were responsible for everything decadent from the white slave trade to syphilis.

Can you see from what we read in Part 1, and now what we are reading here, who is behind all of this? Satan has hated God and everything that belongs to God since the time that he began to rebel and fight against the goodness of God.

The one thing that made Hitler's brand of anti-Semitism so terrible was that it was carried out in a "rational" way which reflected his belief that the elimination of the Jews should be conducted in stages and

through careful planning.

Hitler added a new dimension to the demonic portrayal of Jews and showed them as being nothing more than deadly vermin that had to be eliminated.

To bolster his ideas, he enlisted the support of scientists, philosophers, physicians, and teachers, so that his depiction of the Jews would be accepted by Germany's citizens. This subtle approach worked very well, because many of those who first began boycotting and forcing the Jews out of government were the university students.

There were three very distinct phases to Hitler's non-lethal persecution of the Jews.

Phase 1: Non-Aryans were eliminated from the civil service, legal and medical professions, educational institutions, and any other public offices.

Phase 2: Jews were reduced to second-class citizens in September 1935 with the enactment of the Nuremberg Laws, which effectively mollified the progress the Jews had made during the Emancipation.

Phase 3: Beginning in 1938, all Jewish communities were placed under the control of the Gestapo. All Jews were ordered to register their property, which made it difficult to produce the assets and any capital required to be able to leave the country, despite the fact that until 1939, the Nazi government was encouraging the Jews to leave.

How did the Nazis define who were Jews? A Jew was any person with at least one Jewish grandparent. The intermingling of Aryans and Jews was strictly forbidden. This included both marriage and sexual relations.

Now, in case all of these legal restrictions on the Jews didn't force them to leave, then Hitler had more violent means at his disposal. By 1932, the "Sturmabteilung" (Storm Troopers), or SA, also known as the Brownshirts was growing strong. At a half a-million strong, these recruits were willing henchmen at Hitler's disposal to beat up and even murder Jewish civilians.

On a more official level, Hitler had also established the Schutzstaffel, or SS, the Nazi Party's police and security service under the command of twenty-nine-year-old Heinrich Himmler, who was the son of a Bavarian schoolmaster. The SS were given all the powers of a police force, and were ordered to enforce the restrictive laws on the Jewish people. Later they would carry out and supervise the genocide of the Jews.

Throughout all of the sporadic violence and all of the restrictive conditions, it was not until November 9, 1938, that everything became (Continued on Page 6)

(HISTORY, Continued from Page 4.) clear to the German Jews and to those in the rest of the world who were paying attention, what was actually happening. On that night, which became known as "Kristallnacht" (the night of the broken glass), a well-orchestrated plan was unleashed by the Storm Troopers, along with assorted thugs and hooligans throughout Germany. Hundreds of synagogues were burned, tens of thousands of homes were invaded, many Jews were killed, women were raped, and 30,000 Jews were arrested.

I want to stop here for a moment and ask a question. Do you think something like this could happen in our country? Of course it could. Many people have turned a blind eye to the growing hatred that is developing in our own country. Right now it goes more unnoticed because it happens on such a very small scale, but given the right motivation, or the right fuel, the smallest spurs of violence could escalate into massive outbreaks, which could throw our wonderful, peace loving nation into chaos.

There is still anti-Semitism growing throughout the world. Satan still hates God and his people, and he is well aware that his time is short.

Though most people want to believe that we are in a time of peace, and that we are safe here within our borders, they have a rude awakening coming. We, as God's Children need to continue to watch, and wait, and to be aware that the kettle is about to boil, and to know that God is the only one who can see us through it. CONTINUED NEXT MONTH.

(Commentary, continued from Page 3) are only too aware of what He meant by that. The US, a number one rated nation, was driven out of Vietnam by a 34th rated power. Yet it was not for a lack of courage or skill on the part of our troops. In fact, they never lost a battle. The war however WAS lost, and we now see a war seemingly without end in the Middle East.

We see in Zechariah 14:3-4 that there will come a time when the returning Christ WILL fight the inhabitants of this planet. Since we shall be coming with Him (1Thessalonians 3:13) we shall be in the fight too. And then mankind will beat his swords into plowshares. (Isaiah 2:4).

Until that time we are called to be members of another army. In 2 Timothy 2:3-4 we are told:

(3) Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

(4) No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please Him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

Our weapons in THIS war are listed in Ephesians 6:13-17, the whole armour of God. Our loins fitted with truth, having the breastplate of righteousness, our feet shod with the gospel of truth, the shield of faith, helmet of salvation, and the powerful sword of the spirit also known as the Word of God. A more powerful arsenal you will never find!

Am I suggesting by all this that we as a nation should just toss down our weapons and embrace our enemies? Let me answer that using the SAME answer I used to hear from the then ONLY church work of God, as far as I know, that was being done, which was, as I said above, on the radio coast to coast. If this country would turn WHOLEHEARTEDLY to God, we were taught, from the President and the Congress, all the way down to the man on the street, then we could send our military home, because God would fight our battles for us.

But, if not, the church evangelist further taught, we would need the strongest, toughest military we could have, because that would be ALL we would have to protect us. In later years, that same leader, now deceased, turned from that teaching, but that's another story.

God's Word backs up that teaching from the time God brought ancient Israel out of Egypt. In Exodus 23:20-23, He promised to fight our ancestor Israel's (and our current) battles:

(20) Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way, and to bring you into the place which I have prepared.

(21) Beware of Him and obey His voice: do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; For My name is in Him.

(22) But if you indeed obey His voice and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.

(23) For My Angel will go before you and bring you into the Amorites and the Hittites and the Perrizites and the Cannanites and the Hivites and the Jebusites; and I will cut them off.

God says too in Malachi 3:6 that He does not change. He would do the same for us. We need to face another sobering warning in Deuteronomy 28:25. God tells us there that if we forsake His ways and embrace a life of sin, we will not prevail against our enemies on the battlefields. He also says He will break the PRIDE of our power. (Leviticus 26:19).

As I write this commentary, it was five years ago yesterday that President Bush confidently landed on a carrier in the Iraq war and congratulated our troops on a "Mission Accomplished." Clearly though now we see no end to conflict there or in Afghanistan.

When King Solomon turned from God and built high places in Israel to false gods, a similar thing happened. (1Kings 11:11-12). In verse 14 we are told that GOD stirred up Hadad the Edomite against Solomon and further in verses 23-25 another adversary who reigned in nearby Damascus who was a problem to Israel too. Should we not ask if our sins- national and personal- are not today causing the Great God to bring adversaries against us which we seem incapable of defeating?

We also see a similar occurrence in 2 Kings 24:2-4 where God stirred up nearby bands of neighboring enemies to raid into Judah to destroy it because of its sins:

(2) And the Lord sent against him [against Jehoiakim, king of Judah] bands of the Chaldees, and bands of the Syrians, and bands of the Moabites, and bands of the children of Ammon, and sent them against Judah to destroy it, according to the word of the Lord, which He spake by His servants the prophets.

(3) Surely at the commandment of the Lord came this upon Judah, to remove them **(Continued on Last Page)**

(4) And also for the innocent blood that he shed...

I believe our time is running out as a nation if we do not turn from the evil we are doing in this land and ask God to forgive us and heal us as a nation. We are the modern house of Israel. And God says to us in His Word in Ezekiel 33:11: "Say unto them, As I live, saith the Lord God, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye, from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel."

MACARONI SOUP

To a rich beef or other soup, in which there is no seasoning other than pepper or salt, take half a pound of small pipe macaroni, boil it in clear water until it is tender, then drain it and cut it in pieces of an inch in length, boil it for fifteen minutes in the soup and serve.

Boil an old fowl with an onion, in four quarts of cold water, until there remain but two quarts. Take it out and let it get cold. Cut off the whole of the breast, and chop very fine. Mix with the pounded yolks of two hard-boiled eggs, and rub through a colander. Cool, skim, and strain the soup into a soup-pot. Season, add the chicken and egg mixture, simmer ten minutes, and pour into the tureen. Then add a small cup of boiling milk.
