“What Message Are You Sending Out to People?”

PASS IT ON?

All of us at one time or another, if we have internet access with a computer, have received e-mails from friends and family. Many of these e-mails contain inspiring and interesting material. I'm sure that you have even received forwarded jokes or cartoons and even pictures from these same people.

I receive, on average, approximately 15 to 20 a week, some weeks more and some less. Some of the forwards I receive from outside the Church are not worth reading. Many that I receive from other brethren have interesting content, but normally at the end of the subject matter there is usually a note that says something like, “If you send this to a certain number of people (each one varies), you will receive a blessing,” or some will end by saying something like, “If you love God, or if you love Jesus, you will forward this to ten people.” I have even received some in the past that give great praise to a guardian angel, or just angels in general. A few I received, could easily make a person feel guilty about not passing it on, if it held any truth to it. They said, “Those people that don't love God, or don't love Jesus, or don't care about people will probably delete this message instead of forwarding it on.”

Usually in most cases, if the subject matter is good, I will copy and paste the subject matter only into another email and send it without anything else attached.

I know that some people will just forward them on, not considering the message they are sending out to someone else.

I am quite often troubled by the message that is being passed along by the sender. Should we as God's people be forwarding messages that give praise to angels, or that speak of holidays that we don't observe?

Should we pass on messages that say that we'll get a blessing from God if we pass the message along to so many people? Should we forward any messages that speak of things that are unbiblical? Should we forward messages that say that we don't love God, or Jesus, if we don't pass it along? Of course not!

What kind of messages are we sending to others in or outside of God's Church when we forward these?

What do the messages you forward say about you to the person receiving them? When I get forwards about worldly holidays, I have to question if the person that sent it to me actually believes what they are forwarding. I really start to wonder if they really believe that if they don't forward the message, that they won't receive a blessing, or that God will remove any angel or angels He has given charge over them just because they didn't forward a message.

The message, even if you didn't mean to, could have a harmful effect on the person receiving it, especially if they are new in the Church, or if they're not in the Church yet.

As I said earlier, if the subject matter is good, then copy and paste it, or re-type it without all of the extras and then send it on.

We have to be careful with everything that we do, not only with what we say, but with anything we pass on to someone else too.

Read Romans 14:13 ***“Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.”*** In this verse Paul was speaking about eating food sacrificed to idols, but this verse also includes anything that we do that causes someone else to stumble.

You and I are held accountable before God for everything that we do and so we should consider everything, weighing it carefully before we take any action. This includes any pictures, jokes, stories, etc.

We are ambassadors for the coming Kingdom of God and as its representatives we are responsible for representing it in every avenue of our lives. Read 2 Corinthians 5:20-21 ***“Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”***

We need to ask ourselves, “Does what we are going to do, or say glorify (Continued on Page 6)

God?" If it doesn't, then we should leave it
alone and get rid of it.

We have to use caution in everything we
do and remain aware of any possibility of harm
that could result from the things that we do.

Of course, none of us are perfect and we
will make mistakes, but we can't give up trying
or making an attempt to walk according to the
examples of Jesus. Your friends may not like it
when you don't laugh at their jokes, or if you
choose not to forward something, or if you
choose not to follow the path they are choosing,
but don't be upset by this. It is going to happen if
we choose to put off the ways of this world and
choose to follow God's ways. Peter addressed it
well in his letter in 1 Peter 4:1-11 "*Forasmuch
then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh,
arm yourselves likewise with the same mind:
for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath
ceased from sin; ²That he no longer should live
the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of
men, but to the will of God. ³For the time past
of our life may suffice us to have wrought the
will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lascivi-
ousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, ban-
quetings, and abominable idolatries:*

*⁴Wherein they think it strange that ye run
not with them to the same excess of riot, speak-
ing evil of you: ⁵Who shall give account to him
that is ready to judge the quick and the
dead. ⁶For for this cause was the gospel
preached also to them that are dead, that they
might be judged according to men in the flesh,
but live according to God in the spirit.*

*⁷But the end of all things is at hand: be ye
therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. ⁸And
above all things have fervent charity among
yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude
of sins. ⁹Use hospitality one to another without
grudging. ¹⁰As every man hath received the
gift, even so minister the same one to another,
as good stewards of the manifold grace of
God. ¹¹If any man speak, let him speak as the
oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do
it as of the ability which God giveth: that God
in all things may be glorified through Jesus
Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for
ever and ever. Amen."*

With whatever you do, take time to ask
yourself, "What Message am I sending out?" END

THE THIRD COMMANDMENT?

Commentary by Tom Shadoin

For many of us in God's church who think we're familiar with the Ten Commandments- God's ROYAL law of love according to James 2:8- there may be aspects of the commandments we have not considered. Let's take a look today at the 3rd Commandment. Exodus 20:7:

“You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.”

In the public "entertainment" field (so-called) today, there almost seems to be a CONTEST to see how often this commandment can be broken. It perhaps disturbs me the most to hear even young children throwing around God's name in profanity and otherwise. Many parents, teachers and others apparently see nothing wrong with this language and, no doubt, engage in the same behavior themselves around their children.

What though, brethren, does this commandment really MEAN and what are all the ramifications of this careless and DISRESPECTFUL behavior toward the Creator who made us, and Who sustains our lives every day?

In the popular internet shorthand so widely used today, especially among young people, can you guess what OMG means? Hint, the first two words are "OH MY...." This is unbelievable brethren. It is flippant, disrespectful, and ironic at the same time. Ironic because many or most of the people who so casually throw around the Creator's name either don't believe He exists or at least have serious doubts that He does.

What then does God's Word have to say regarding How and WHEN we are to use His name? In the so-called Lord's prayer, which is really a model prayer, which Jesus used in teaching His disciples how to pray, He taught us to say "hallowed be thy name." Matthew 6:9. God's name has great power behind it. By the rude, flippant bantering around of it, we in effect act to CHEAPEN it. Why then would we ever expect God to hear us when we invoke His name in prayer?

Still another misuse of God's name is mentioned in Matt. 23:9:

“Do not call anyone on earth your father; for One is your Father, He who is in heaven.”

Clearly this refers to the TITLE and not the reference to our earthly fathers as this word is used for that purpose elsewhere. (Ephesians 6:4; Colossians 3:21.) One major professing Christian organization as we all know, uses that name as a title but ALSO calls their leader "holy father." Brethren we have only ONE "HOLY FATHER" and He resides in heaven and not in Rome. Further we are told in Psalm 111:9:

“He has sent redemption to His people; He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name.”

Such words or titles should never be tacked on before the name of any man. Now I want to point out some things that many in God's church may never have considered are a violation of God's Third Commandment. If we look in the Merriam Webster dictionary under words such as "gosh, golly, gee whiz", etc. we see that all of them are euphemisms (or substitutes) for the name of God. It's just as wrong to use these words brethren and this practice, too, is the taking of God's name in vain.

We might want to consider that if we DO diligently try to honor, respect and yes, REVERE God's name, when we DO call on Him in His holy name to ask His help, He is more likely to hear us. Isaiah 59:2:

“But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So He will not hear.”

And let's not forget that this applies to the name of our Savior as well. In fact, it was He who wrote these commandments and was otherwise with the children of Israel in the Sinai desert during all those journeys. I Corinthians. 10:1-4:

**(1) Moreover, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea,
(2) all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea,
(3) all ate the same spiritual food,
(4) and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.**

The last area I want to discuss concerning an aspect of taking God's name in vain is that we REPRESENT Him and His name as His people. And in Proverbs 22:1 we are told: (Continued on Last Page.)

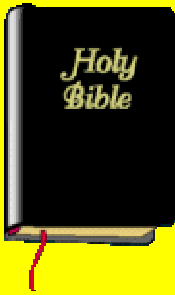

Trinidad & Tobago: This is an island just off the coast of Venezuela in South America. Mr. James, the local minister has asked us to be their sister Church and to share ideas and help in spreading the Gospel in both of our areas. We presently send newsletter and DVD sermons to them each month.

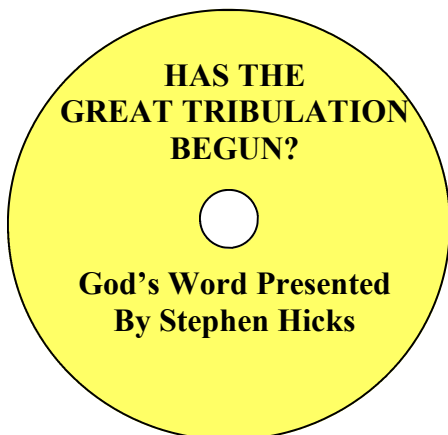

“A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favor rather than silver and gold.”

Just as those of you with children don't want THEM to do anything to embarrass YOUR good name, neither should we by our example do anything to embarrass God. Jesus said in Luke 6:46:

“And why call ye me Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?”

“Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my father which is in heaven.”

Let's make our Heavenly Father proud of us brethren, so that we may hear our Savior say when He returns:

“Well done, thou good and faithful servant”
