## Commentary by Tom Shadoin

### Christians & Voting

I was astounded to once hear a pastor in a worldly church say that you can't be a Christian if you don't vote. The idea that ANY Christian could wind up in the lake of fire for failing to vote boggles the mind. Apparently this misguided pastor felt he'd found the Eleventh Commandment. I also once heard that same opinion expressed by a deacon in the churches of God, who then went on to try to back his opinion up with a scripture, namely Titus 3:1:

Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work.

He apparently overlooked the fact that, when that scripture was written, the Roman Empire held sway and there WAS no voting for leaders. But, even IF Christians COULD have voted, how could they have participated in such a corrupt system as that of Rome? Vote for the Caesar of your choice BUT vote! It just doesn't seem to have the RING to it one might hope for, even if, as I said, voting had even been the method of choosing governments at that time.

Still other Christians have expressed the opinion that we need to vote even though ALL the leaders and potential leaders are flawed. Then the reasoning goes, we could at least choose the "lesser of two evils," therefore they reason that things wouldn't fall apart as fast as they would anyway. But that idea, when you think about it, STILL requires us to vote for EVIL doesn't it, EVEN if the lesser of the two? But is that what God's word says? That we are to COMPROMISE with evil so that we may TEMPORARILY- we hope- gain some advantage for our world by fashioning a better world order? I think not! In 3 John 11 we read:

Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

Or, how about 1 Thessalonians 5:22: Abstain from all appearance of evil.

And in Daniel 4:17 we read that there is only ONE who decides who rules and who doesn't.

“This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the Most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.”

And Daniel 2:21:

“And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:”

Jeremiah 27:5:

“I have made the earth, the men and the beasts that are upon the ground, by my great power and by my outstretched arm, and have given it unto whom it seemed meet unto me.”

We further read in 2 Corinthians 5:20 that we are ambassadors for a kingdom yet to come and our hopes and dreams do not lie with this current sin- sick system. Christ is holding our citizenship in heaven (Philippians 3:20) and will bestow it on us when He comes. (Revelation 22:12).

## HISTORY OF THE JEWS, PART 7 (From Holocaust to Present)

**Many of us have heard bits and pieces of Jewish history, but often times there are gaps in what we have come to understand. As I began to study on this subject I found that there were gaps in my understanding of the Holocaust and what events have brought the Jews to where they are today and what has kept them in a constant state of alert. Even today, the state of Israel remains on alert, wondering when things will explode again, launching them into another battle for the Promised Land.**

With over 6 million Jews murdered, the world was forced to acknowledge the need for a secure place where Jews could live. On November 29, 1947, the United Nations voted in favor of the partition of Palestine into two states - Jewish and Arab.

Almost immediately after this decision, violence erupted in Palestine, with more than 1,000 Jewish, Arab, and British fatalities.

Over the next few months, an unknown number of assaults were carried out against the Jews. At this same time the British began to withdraw their troops and officials turning over their fortifications and weapons to the Arabs.

Although the United Nations held the Arabs responsible for the violence, nothing was ever done to

enforce the Partition Plan. **(This sounds familiar, doesn't it?)** While many of the nations gave verbal support to the Jewish homeland, none stepped in to help them. In fact, the United States imposed an arms embargo to the region, which favored the Arabs.

The Haganah, which was later named the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF), was very poorly armed with 17,600 rifles, 2,700 stenguns, 1,000 machine guns, and practically no heavy artillery or aircraft. It's soldiers numbered between 20,000 to 40,000 men in various stages of training.

The Arab Liberation Army was joined by 30,000 well trained troops from Egypt, Syria, Iraq, Lebanon, and the Arab Legion of Transjordan.

Despite all of the violence and chaos, all of the Jewish leaders pushed for independence, and on May 14, 1948, David Ben Gurion read the Scroll of Independence, declaring "the establishment of a Jewish state in Palestine, which will be known as the State of Israel." During his speech, David Ben Gurion proclaimed that, "The State of Israel will be open for Jewish immigration and the ingathering of the exiles.

After his speech, a provisional government was formed, and that night the people celebrated the birth of their State. That same day, unfortunately marked the beginning of the War of Independence. While the Israelis were still dancing and celebrating in the streets, the Arabs launched an attack. Egyptian aircraft began an assault that sought to annihilate the new Jewish state.

The IDF fought the Arab armies knowing that their survival depended on it. In mid October of 1948, the IDF launched an offensive in the Negev; and by the end of the year, with a military 100,000 strong, Israel was in control on the ground.

The Israeli forces not only managed to defend themselves, but in doing so they also captured the cities of Tiberias, Haifa, Safed, Jaffa, and Acre. Unfortunately the Old City of Jerusalem was lost after a hard fought battle. Jerusalem would remain divided until fighting again began in 1967.

More than 6,000 Jews died during their War for Independence.

In January 1949, armistice talks were held on the island of Rhodes, and during the next six months, armistice agreements were signed with Egypt, Lebanon, Transjordan, and Syria. Iraq refused to sign an accord.

In 1950, the Knesset (Israeli parliament) enacted the Law of Return, which granted every Jew the right to emigrate to Israel and become a citizen.

# God's Creation All Around Us

God's great wisdom never ceases to amaze me when I look at His wonderful Creation around me. Many of those creations are very small and can sometimes go unnoticed.

A few weeks back, Teresa and I were getting in the car, for a day of shopping, and as I opened the car door, I noticed what appeared to be a glob of something on top of the car. My first thought was that a bird had bombed the car, but upon taking a closer look, I realized that it was a tiny tree frog, warming itself in the early morning sun.

I knew that it would never remain attached for the ride into town, so I gently placed my hand over its little body and proceeded to pick it up. Well, anyone who has ever picked up a toad or a frog knows that their main



defense system, other than hopping away, is to urinate on their captor.

This little guy must have been holding it in for awhile. I refer to the frog as a guy only because I've never tried to hold a live kicking frog on its back to see what sex it was.

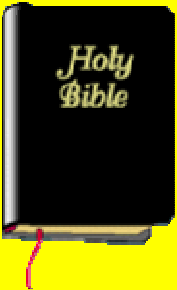
On the top of the car, this little frog really stood out, but as soon as I laid him down on a big rock by the driveway, it seemed as though he almost disappeared. God had given this little one a great camouflage. I didn't have time to examine him any longer because of our shopping engagement, but it stayed on my mind the whole day.

Later on, when we arrived home, guess what I did? As soon as I got out of the car, I started hunting for the frog. I didn't know if I'd find him, and he wasn't on the rock any longer, so I began to look up and down the oak tree next to the big rock. As I was searching the trunk of the tree I noticed an empty Cicada shell attached to the bark. The empty shell is what remains after the Cicadas crawl out of the ground and break out of their shells to fly into the trees. As I reached out to grab the shell, I noticed a tiny movement to the right of it, and right there before my eyes was the frog, so well camouflaged that if he hadn't moved, I never would have noticed him. If you look at the picture above you will see the Cicada shell in the left center of the picture and just a tiny bit to the right of the shell is the tree frog. You will also notice that the frog isn't much bigger than the shell. Curled up, the frog was barely 2 inches long. In the photo above and to the right, you can see the Cicada shell at the very left of the picture, and you can also see how well the frog's camouflage works.

I put a circle around the frog in the picture below left in case you still couldn't find him, and I blew up a side view shot of him so that you can see his eye. I was fascinated with this tiny little frog. We have a lot of tree frogs around our place, and they come in various sizes and colors, all to match their surroundings.

One night we were sitting in the family room and got to enjoy watching some dark green tree frogs climbing up and down the sliding glass door, catching bugs with their tongues as the insects flew towards the light they saw through the glass. Each spring we are serenaded by thousands of these little singers as they chirp out their mating calls. The next time your out walking, look closely at everything, because you might just be closer to God's little creations than you think. END

(HISTORY, Continued from Page 4.) emigrated to Israel in the first three years, which doubled the population. The largest number of these immigrations were the Holocaust survivors, while others came from Libya, Yemen, and Iraq. During the next ten years immigrants began arriving from North Africa, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, Poland, and Hungary, which were all lands that were inhospitable to Jews.

Tens of thousands of Jews left the U.S. and returned to Israel. Many others came from Canada, South Africa, and Western Europe. Over a million Jews have immigrated from Russia. **(Today, three out of every five Jews living in Israel were born somewhere else. Israel continues to call itself the land of ingathering.)**

Following the signing of the armistice agreements in 1949, the Arabs insisted on two preconditions before they would even come to the table to discuss peace. First, they demanded that Israel return to the 1947 borders set up in the Partition Resolution that the Arabs had rejected to begin with. Second, the Arabs wanted all of the Palestinian refugees, who had left during the war, to be allowed back into Israel. With neither of the conditions satisfied, Egypt led the way in maintaining a state of belligerence against Israel.

Eventually in 1956, fighting broke out again over the matter of the Suez Canal. The canal was built by the British, and Britain continued to rely on it for a quick passage to the Red Sea and Saudi Arabia. Israel relied on the canal also, but was continuously denied passage.

Tensions increased when the Soviet (Continued on Page 10)

**(Commentary, continued from Page 3)** House also throws the switch to light the national Christmas tree and also hosts the annual Easter egg roll on the White house lawn. Both traditions are, as you know, pagan to the core.

“Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.” 2 Corinthians 6:17.

There will be no voting in God's kingdom. God's slate of candidates- make that LEADERS- is to a great extent already decided- David and the twelve apostles. But He still has openings. You and I can work in that Godly system too and can be among the tens of thousands of saints that return with Him. (Matthew 19:28; Revelation 20:4; Jude 14).

Brethren many of God's people seem to feel that somehow if they don't get busy and vote for the "best" leaders somehow God's plans may be foiled. But we can see from the scriptures we've looked at so far that our God is sovereign and doesn't need our help fixing this world.

Let's keep our eyes on the true goal we were created for and not get sidetracked by promises and hopes that will soon fade away.

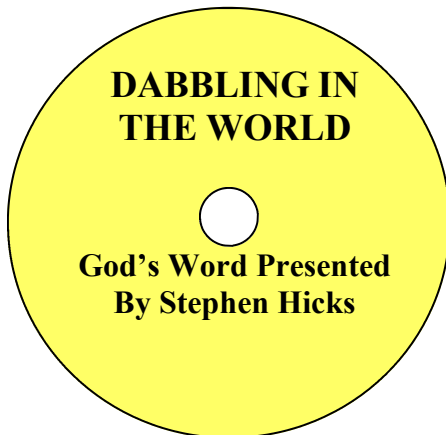

**(History of the Jews, continued from Page 6)** Union pulled their support from Israel and began supporting the Arab nations. In 1955, the Arabs received shipments of heavy armaments from Russia.

At this same time, Israel was suffering from terrorist attacks launched by fedayeen, who had been trained in Egypt and who were coming in to Israel via Jordan.

In July of 1956, Egyptian President Gamal Abdel-Nasser set up a blockade in the Straits of Tiran and nationalized the Suez Canal. In October, he signed an agreement with Syria and Jordan, placing their forces under his command.

It looked to Israel that once again, the Arabs were preparing for war, and so to pre-empt any attack, on October 29, 1956, Israel struck first with an attack upon Egypt.

Britain and France were also concerned over the blockades in the canal and so they joined Israel in the fight. The IDF routed the Egyptians and captured almost all of the Sinai Peninsula.

When the United States and the Soviet Union learned of the attack, they pressured Israel, Britain, and France through the United Nations to return all of the captured territories.

In return for giving back the captured areas, the U.N. dispatched troops of the U.N. Emergency force to supervise the vacated territories and guarantee international shipping.
