Under a Curse

Stephen Hicks

Greetings to everyone reading this newsletter in the name of our Lord Jesus, the Christ.

Most of you are aware, if you've been watching the news that a major part of the U.S. has been under an excessive heat warning for quite some time now. I was watching the news this morning and the news commentators were showing pictures of hayfields in the south. The fields were covered with a lot of brown dried up grasses, as far as the eye could see. These are fields that are used to grow hay for cattle and other livestock. Without this harvest, farmers will be forced into making the choice of either trying to buy hay from other states, which will be very costly or to sell off their livestock. The only other option, if they can't find or buy food for them, is to watch them starve. They are also facing the possibility of their livestock dying of thirst due to the fact that many of their water sources have dried up too.

We are already seeing rising meat prices in the local stores. If the farmers begin losing their livestock or if they should have to purchase outside feed sources, then the consumers will see the prices in their local markets soar even higher.

While all of this is going on, we have a government that continues arguing over what to do about the budget and the huge deficit that has been created over the past several years.

When I watch the back and forth fighting and arguing with no party wanting to agree to the others ideas, I think of young schools kids fighting with each other. One side says, "You have to do it my way, or I'm not going to play," while the other kid is saying the same thing, so no one wins.

Everything that we see happening around us was prophesied long ago and can be found in the pages of our bible.

Let's begin by discussing the drought. Several years ago during a dry summer, I was digging some fence posts for a customer. I noticed, while digging these holes, that after I got through the top soil and began digging into the clay that the clay was very dry and would crumble every time I tried to lift it out of the hole. I knew that if the ground had good moisture content the clay would have been soft and should have been easy to lift out of the hole. Even digging down between three and four feet normally would have yielded wet clay. This clay was so dry that it would fall out of my digging tool before I could pull it to the surface. I finally had to lie down on my side on the ground and lift the clay out a handful at a time. This entire challenge really got my curiosity up because in all my years of digging holes I had never experienced this before. My hole digging experience was met with an answer a few months later as I was listening to some farmers at the local coffee shop (Continued on Page 6)

(Curse, Continued from Page 3.) and heard them talking about how the water tables were drying up under ground and how the long term effects of this could be devastating to crops and the ground as a whole. Now again, this was something that I experienced over ten years ago. I knew what was prophesied about the heavens and the earth and I began to wonder then if this was the beginning of a curse upon this and other nations.

When God spoke to the Israelites and warned them of the curses for disobedience, one of those curses dealt with the sky and the ground.

Deuteronomy 28:23-24 **“And thy heaven that is over thy head shall be brass, and the earth that is under thee shall be iron. The Lord shall make the rain of thy land powder and dust: from heaven shall it come down upon thee, until thou be destroyed.”**

Many have said that this was a prophecy for Israel and was for them only. If we understand that God is the same yesterday, today and forever, then we should clearly see that if He cursed Israel for their disobedience, it would stand as fact that He would punish others for that same disobedience.

The other day I heard a newscaster say that Texas is predicting that if they don't get rain soon, they will be facing another dust bowl that would rival the Dust Bowl days of many years ago.

The same warning can be found in Leviticus 26:18-19 **“And if ye will not yet for all this hearken unto me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins. And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass:”**

The people of this nation cannot continue to disobey God in the use of the land that He has given us by not letting the land rest each seven years or offering the first fruits of our harvest to God. Today the greed of mankind drives them to lay one crop over the top of another crop harvested without giving the land time to rest and to be renewed. This is called “no till” farming. Farmer's used to plow their fields, aerating the soil by turning the remaining stubble of the old crops under, while bringing fresh soil to the top. Now, by using the “no till” planting they don't roll the soil. Instead the planter they use barely breaks through the surface a few inches to place the seed under the surface. The more they do this, the harder the ground will get just under the surface. Most field crops are genetically altered to grow, even in diverse conditions that unaltered, heirloom seed would never grow in. If man would have obeyed God and wouldn't have tried to improve upon His creation, we would have pure crops that our bodies could easily digest, instead of the mutations that we find in most stores today. This is just one part of the problems we are facing today.

The floods that we have seen and will continue to see in the future, will continue to wash away the good top soil needed to grow anything, replacing it with sand that nothing but weeds will grow in.

The extreme heat we are having in the nation and around the world right now is just a warning. Either mankind declares a fast, getting on their knees right now and turning to God with deep heartfelt repentance or the sky will become as hard as brass and the ground like iron. The only thing that will grow will be the dust for the wind to carry from place to place. I read a news article that was talking about having to test dust to see where it originated. I didn't quite understand the need for this until they explained that dust carrying chemicals like weed killers and insecticides could be transported in dust storms and could carry these toxins into other areas where they could be devastating to good insects or crops.

Earlier in this article I wrote about our government acting like school kids. Now I will show you a prophecy that proclaims the government we have in place now. Isaiah 3:10-12 **“Say ye to the righteous, that it shall be well with him: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings. Woe unto the wicked! it shall be ill with him: for the reward of his hands shall be given him. As for my people, children are their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause thee to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.”**

There is a promise of a blessing and a curse written in these verses. The blessing is upon the righteous of God. He says clearly that it will be well with them. The children of God, if they are looking with spiritual eyes should be able to see what is truly going on within our government today. We have men and women in our government who are looking after their own selfish interests and are not listening to the people. As the verse said, “...they which lead thee cause thee to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.” Our government is leading this nation down the wrong path by the choices that they are making. They speak lies to the nation telling them that everything is going to be alright and the majority of the nation is buying into it. They twist the facts, to make them easier for the ear to hear. The reason many in this nation are buying into it is because they aren't feeling the real effects of it yet. Let me stress YET!!!

It is easy for people to be content when they are living comfortably, when they have just about everything they need. They have a job, they have a roof over them, they easily make all of their monthly payments and their bellies are full. When people get comfortable, God begins to drift further from their thoughts. They are content, with no worries, so they put God aside until the next time they need Him. Even this attitude and mindset is prophesied. In the following verses, it is speaking about Jerusalem, but as I said earlier, God is not biased. No one is exempt from God's wrath if they walk contrary to Him without repentance. To continue to walk in sin will bring about punishment upon the disobedient.

Deuteronomy 32:15-25 **“But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered with fatness; then he forsook God which made him, and lightly esteemed the Rock of his (Continued on Page 7.)**

(Curse, continued from Page 6.) salvation. They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger. They sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not. Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee. And when the Lord saw it, he abhorred them, because of the provoking of his sons, and of his daughters. And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith. They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation. For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains. I will heap mischiefs upon them; I will spend mine arrows upon them. They shall be burnt with hunger, and devoured with burning heat, and with bitter destruction: I will also send the teeth of beasts upon them, with the poison of serpents of the dust. The sword without, and terror within, shall destroy both the young man and the virgin, the suckling also with the man of gray hairs.

Take time to read the rest of Deuteronomy, chapter 32. Jeshurun is another name used to describe Jerusalem. God knew ahead of time that the hearts of the people would turn from Him and His ways once they were comfortable in the Promised Land. It is no different in our country today. Many people turn to God when they have needs, but when those needs are fulfilled, God doesn't seem as important to them and it becomes easier for them to drift back into doing what they want instead of being obedient to God and living according to His will.

But, what happens when their comfortable lifestyle is ripped away from them? How do they react when they lose the job they were depending on and they can't pay their bills any longer. How do they react when their home is being foreclosed on and their vehicles are being repossessed? What happens when they can't afford to buy food for themselves or their family? What happens when the government checks don't come anymore to those who are on Social Security Disability or S.S. Income? What's going to happen when Medicare and Medicaid dry up? Where will the people turn? Where will they turn if in a moment everything that they held dearly is ripped from their grasp? Most in the world will turn to the government asking what that government is going to do for them. When they find that the government can't help them, then they will curse them for not doing the job they were elected to do. We've seen a few small uprisings in this country when people have been denied pay or services that they feel are owed to them? Most of the people in this country will not take any of the blame on themselves for the choices that they freely made. God's people should know where their trust needs to be.

Psalm 40:4 **“Blessed is that man that maketh the Lord his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.”**

Psalm 118:8-9 **“It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man. It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in princes.”**

As God's children we should hopefully know better than to put our trust anywhere except in the Lord, our God. There are so many verses that confirm the benefits of trusting Him with our lives. Following are just a few of them.

Psalm 4:5 **“Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the Lord.”**

Psalm 9:9-10 **“The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, Lord, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.”**

Shew thy marvellous lovingkindness, O thou that savest by thy right hand them which put their trust in thee from those that rise up against them. Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings, From the wicked that oppress me, from my deadly enemies, who compass me about.”**

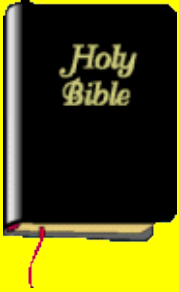

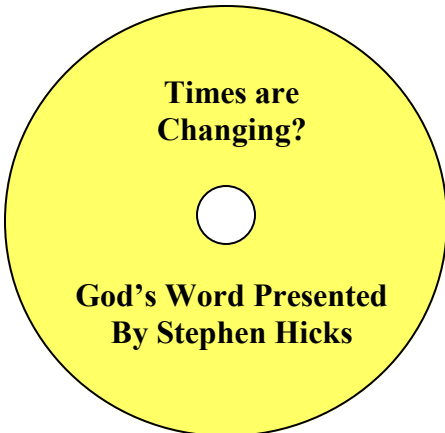

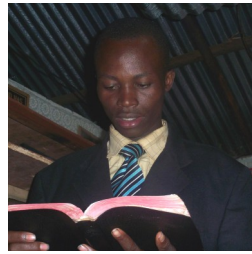
