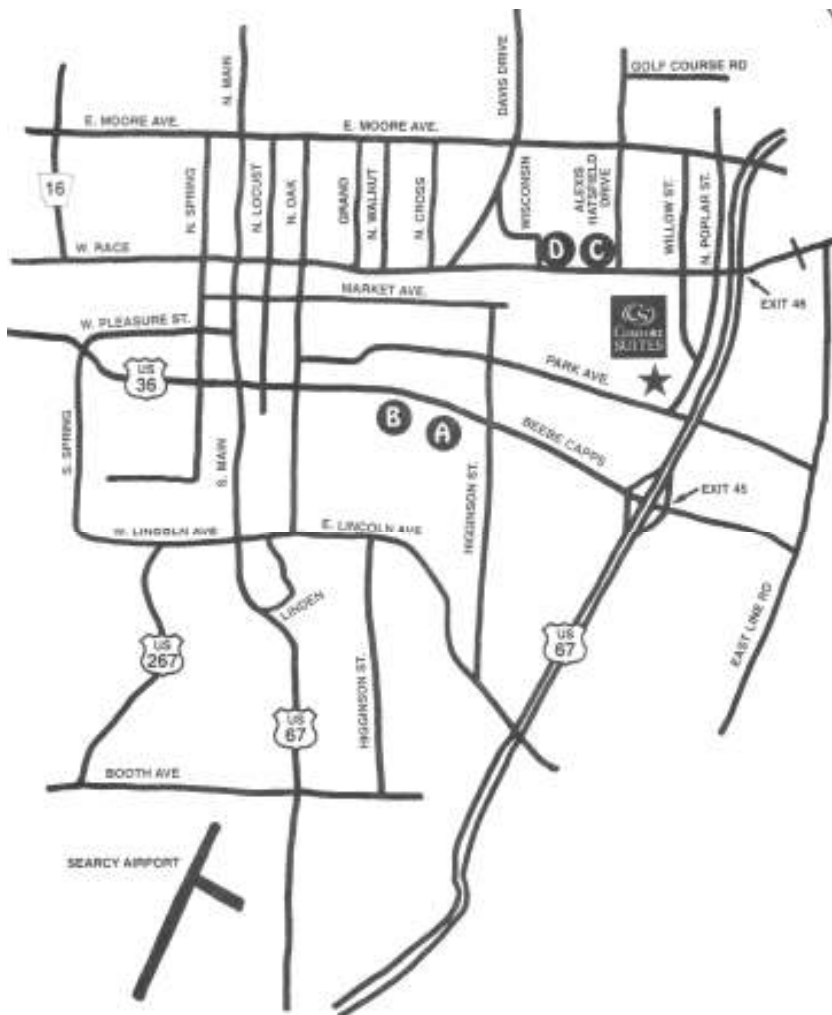

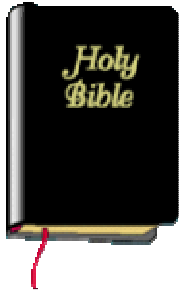

## The Feasts of God - Leviticus 23

### Feast of Unleavened Bread

<sup>1</sup>And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, <sup>2</sup>Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, *Concerning* the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, *even* these *are* my feasts. <sup>3</sup>Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day *is* the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work *therein*: it *is* the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings. <sup>4</sup>These *are* the feasts of the LORD, *even* holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons. <sup>5</sup>In the fourteenth *day* of the first month at even *is* the LORD'S passover. <sup>6</sup>And on the fifteenth day of the same month *is* the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

### Pentecost

<sup>15</sup>And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete: <sup>16</sup>Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

### Feast of Trumpets & Atonement

<sup>23</sup>And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, <sup>24</sup>Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first *day* of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation. <sup>25</sup>Ye shall do no servile work *therein*: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD. <sup>26</sup>And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, <sup>27</sup>Also on the tenth *day* of this seventh month *there shall be* a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

### Feast of Tabernacles & Last Great Day

<sup>33</sup>And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, <sup>34</sup>Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month *shall be* the feast of tabernacles *for* seven days unto the LORD. <sup>35</sup>On the first day *shall be* an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work *therein*. <sup>36</sup>Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it *is* a solemn assembly; *and* ye shall do no servile work *therein*.
