Proof of the bible

When I first came into the church several decades ago, one of the first things I studied was how to prove the Bible is the inspired infallible Word of God. It wouldn't make much sense to spend all of the time studying it as we do if it is riddled with errors as some claim. In fact, brethren, it seems to me that even ONE error in the bible would disqualify it from being a book we could ever rely on. For wouldn't that mean that the God whose book, it claims in it pages to be, is also flawed and also not to be depended upon? But God IS both perfect AND dependable as is His Holy Word, the Bible.

Matthew 5:48 "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect."

2 Timothy 3:16-17 "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

By perfect I do not mean that there are not occasionally MINOR errors in translation or even OCCASIONALLY things added which should not be in the Holy Bible. Also bear in mind that when we see an *italicized* word in the Bible, it means that word was added by translators to try to clarify the sentence. Those additions are not always correct. But I repeat, overall and **AS A WHOLE** the Bible is accurate and conveys to Man what God wants him to know.

There are so many PROOFS that the Bible is accurate and dependable that I hardly know where to begin. In fact, this article may have to be continued in one or more subsequent articles.

One of the objections often raised when proving the bible accurate is that the things WRITTEN in the bible itself are used AS that proof. In other words, the Bible is used to prove the Bible. How can we know, it is asked, that these writings are really as old as claimed? And how can we know that the things written in it- especially the prophecies- weren't written AFTER the fact. Good question. The answer is that both the Old and New Testaments are supported by numerous early handwritten manuscript copies from different sources and ALL basically agree with each other as to content. In the case of the New Testament, we are talking about over 20,000 known manuscripts, all made before the advent of (Continued on Page 7)

(Continued from Page 3) the printing press.

Perhaps the most famous of these are the so called Dead Sea scrolls found in 1947 in an ancient long abandoned Jewish religious settlement of Qumran, Israel. A couple of years ago two other brethren and I had the privilege of seeing an impressive exhibit of some of the scrolls (mostly fragments) when it was on display in Kansas City, Missouri. The documents came from the "library" of the Qumran settlement and dated from 150 B.C. to 70 A.D. Even though coming from a variety of sources, and written in different languages by people of many different nationalities, cultures, and backgrounds, the manuscripts all basically agree with modern texts. Incidentally, as to authenticity, no other non-biblical ancient writings have so much proof to back them up as does the Bible!

All that being said, let's look at specific, fulfilled prophecies of the Bible. In the prophet Isaiah's day, the ancient city-state of Babylon was the world's great political and religious capitol of its day. It might be compared to what New York City is to the modern world today. See what God's Word said about its fate back then, over 2500 years ago:

Isaiah 13:19-22: "And Babylon, the glory of the kingdoms, the beauty of the Chaldean's pride, will be as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah. It will never be inhabited, nor will it be settled from generation to generation; nor will the Arabian pitch tents there, nor will the shepherds make their sheepfolds there. But wild beasts of the desert will lie there, and their houses will be full of owls; ostriches will dwell there, and wild goats will caper there. The hyenas will howl in their citadels, and jackals in their pleasant palaces. Her time is near to come, and her days will not be prolonged."

At the time this was written, there was absolutely NO reason to think this could ever happen. The city of Babylon at its zenith must have been breathtaking. Its famous hanging gardens were among the seven wonders of the ancient world. But today, a museum and a few wild animals are all that inhabit that area. You may recall Sadaam Hussein once saying he would rebuild Babylon to its ancient glory. But both he AND Babylon are now a fading memory.

Isaiah predicted that this desolation would occur some 600 years before Christ. Only an ALL WISE, all powerful God could have possibly made this known to him. Here, indeed, in fulfilled prophecy lies a major proof of God.

Another fulfilled prophecy is in Zephaniah, Chapter 2. Zephaniah wrote about 630 B.C. There is

much duality (prophecies for then and at the same time for now) in this book, and it is beyond the scope of this article to discuss all that. What I do want to concentrate on is in verses 4-7 which refers to an ancient foe of the Israelites, the Philistines and some of their cities.

Zephaniah 2:4-7: "For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon desolate; they shall drive out Ashdod at noonday, and Ekron shall be uprooted. Woe to the inhabitants of the seacoast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the Lord against you, O Canaan, land of the Philistines: I will destroy you so there shall be no inhabitant. The seacoast shall be pastures, with shelters for shepherds and folds for flocks. The coast shall be for the remnant of the house of Judah; they shall feed their flocks there; in the houses of Ashkelon they shall lie down at evening. For the Lord their God will intervene for them, and return their captives."

Today the Philistines are no more, nor are the Cherethites, who were a tribe of the Philistines. Also today, this area is in fact within the nation of Israel, which we know is ACTUALLY mainly made up of the tribe of Judah (see verse 7 above). Again, more fulfilled prophecy.

Another major proof of the bible is science, that is, TRUE science. True science supports the scriptures and doesn't contradict them.

Romans 1: 20: "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,"

As we all no doubt remember learning in school, that until a few hundred years ago, "scientists" and religious leaders were SURE the earth was flat. But, let's see what God's Word said about this clear back in the book of Isaiah:

Isaiah 40: 21-22: "Have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not been told you from the beginning? Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth? It is he who sits above the **circle** of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers..." (Emphasis mine.)

CIRCLE of the earth? Not flat? So here we see that God was AHEAD of the "wise men" of that day as He is ahead of the so-called scientists today who teach evolution and the absence of a Creator God.

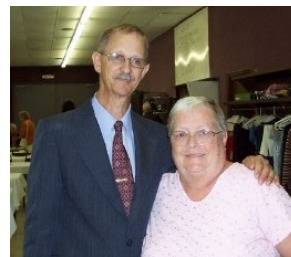

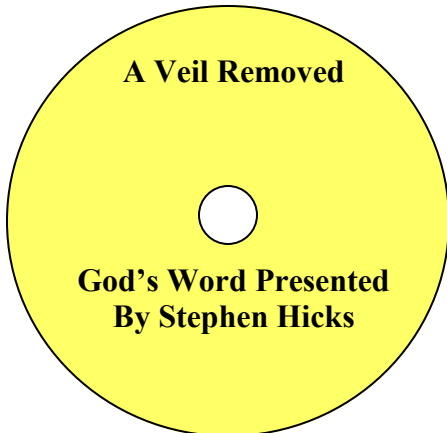
Once they are translated, we hope to be able to reprint copies of them and send them back to the Philippines and to put them on the Church website so that others who speak these languages can benefit from them also.
